The accelerated Master of Science in Criminal Justice degree program allows qualified undergraduate students to take up to four classes in their senior year that may count for undergraduate and graduate credit. You may apply for the accelerated program once you have completed 60 hours of undergraduate coursework. However, you may not enroll in 500 level courses until 75 hours of undergraduate coursework have been completed.

Program Requirements

- Junior Standing with at least 75 credit hours completed.
- Limit of 12 hours (500 level).
- Minimum grade point average of 3.0.
- Submit formal application.

Program Notes

- Course fee will be at the undergraduate rate.
- Course will be initially recorded as undergraduate class at the end of semester.
- After grades are submitted at the end of the semester, the courses will be added to your graduate course list for graduate credit.
